ARTICULATION AGREEMENT BETWEEN  
THE COLLEGE OF CHARLESTON  
AND  
TRIDENT TECHNICAL COLLEGE

The College of Charleston School of Business and Economics will accept from Trident Technical College those courses with a grade of "C" or better indicated by Exhibits A and B (attached) that are applicable for students who are pursuing a Bachelors degree in Hospitality and Tourism Management from the College of Charleston. The specific courses that will apply for an individual student may vary depending on the number of courses successfully completed at the time of enrollment at the College of Charleston, but may not exceed 60 semester hours.

This transfer agreement is based on the 2004-2005 catalog of the respective institutions and is applicable for future catalogs providing that neither institution has made curricula, program, or graduation requirement changes. Each institution agrees to notify the other when any changes are made so that this articulation agreement can be reviewed and amended as needed. This agreement is contingent upon the approval of the College of Charleston receiving all internal and external approvals for a Bachelors Degree in Hospitality and Tourism Management.

Each party understands this agreement is not a blanket or universal transfer agreement that covers all students seeking to transfer from Trident Technical College to the College of Charleston. No special waiver of admissions standards to the College of Charleston is implied in this agreement. Further, admission requirements for transfer students to the College of Charleston, as specified by the current catalog, will be met. This agreement is expressly applicable only for those students who have been granted admission by the College of Charleston to the School of Business and Economics in the Hospitality and Tourism Management program.

This agreement may be renounced by either party. Such termination will become effective after the end of the academic year in which one institution notifies the other, in writing, of its intention to terminate the agreement.
